UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

In continuation of this Court's Orders dated 30th September, 2011, and 13th December, 2011, we are of the view that time has come for the

Central Government to inform the Court as to
what steps they intend to take in the matter of
disposal of raw material, which is hexa
chloro cyclo
pentadiene [hccp for short],
lying with the three Companies, one of which is
a Public Sector

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Company. The Central Government will also ascertain the quantity of raw material, i.e., hccp, which is lying with the three Companies and the manner in which the said raw material would be disposed of, whether in bulk or in phased manner. Secondly, the Central Government will also inform this Court as to the disposal of the final product which, we are told, is Endosulfan and which is lying in two Forms, one is Endosulfan Tech. and other is Endosulfan Formulation. We are informed that the quantity of Endosulfan Formulation lying for disposal, as of date, is 1300 KL. We are further informed that Endosulfan Tech. has been exported, pursuant to our earlier Orders, to the tune of 1090.596 MT. Subject to checking the figures, broadly, we reiterate that the Central Government shall submit its Report as to the manner of disposal of hccp and the final product and the period within which the same shall be disposed of/phased out. The Central Government shall place the Report by the second week of July, 2012.

Place the matter on 23rd July, 2012.
